
Summary of Butcher Corner Park Community Meeting June 20, 2018 6:30pm Rolling Hills Estates City Hall



- 25 residents in attendance. See list of attendees that signed in below. Emails will be provided to the City in a separate document.
- 30 suggestions made regarding park amenities/design features
- Each attendee was given 3 votes for which amenity/feature they want at the park. Total of 75 votes were cast. Attached graph shows results of voting.
- Residents that were unable to attend meeting emailed their suggestions. All suggestions except one were voiced at the meeting. The one suggestion not mentioned is included in the attached graph.
- Residents unanimously agreed that all features/amenities should reflect the natural landscape of the city. Natural colors, textures, materials are preferred.
- Safety of park visitors was a common concern. Park site is located on the 3rd busiest corner in the area. Consultant will confer with local authorities as to how to best address these concerns
- Residents suggested a number of local parks that could be referred to as reference. Consultant will research these parks:
  - South Park in Hermosa
  - Fort Lots of Fun in Hermosa
  - Sea View Park in Hermosa
  - Buccaneer Park in Oceanside
  - Parklets near Jefferson Elementary in Redondo
  - Resevoir Park in Signal Hill
