Under California's recent legislation, Senate Bill 1383, organics now includes yard waste, food waste and food soiled paper. Residents should continue using their kitchen pails to collect food scraps. To encourage residents and businesses to recycle, the City of Rolling Hills Estates and WM provide one residential or commercial customer per quarter with free services for a year. Don't miss your opportunity to be in the running for free services. You will also receive a signed certificate from the Mayor for your continued efforts.

## Holiday Tree Recycling

WM will collect holiday trees at no charge during the first two weeks following Christmas Day on your scheduled collection day. After the two-week period, you may cut your tree and place the pieces in your green WM cart with the lids completely closed. If the tree is too large to fit into your cart, please leave it out next to your carts on your normally scheduled service day.



### How to Prepare Your Holiday Tree for Collection

- Trees taller than six (6) feet must be cut in half
- Remove all decorations including tinsel, lights, ornaments and tree stands
- Flocked trees will be collected, but cannot be recycled

## Preparing for Spring Cleaning

Don't forget that Rolling Hills Estates residents may request four (4) free bulky-item collections per year, of up to five items per collection. Residents that have extra trash can also use one of their bulky item collections to dispose of up to ten (10) 32-gallon bags of trash.
