MINUTES

REGULAR PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING

NOVEMBER 15, 2004

A regular meeting of the Planning Commission of the City of Rolling Hills Estates was called to order at 7:31 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers, 4045 Palos Verdes Drive North, by CHAIRMAN KILLEN.

2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

8. PUBLIC HEARINGS

A. PLANNING APPLICATION NO 07-04; APPLICANT: DAVE FARRELL; LOCATION: 10 HIDDEN VALLEY ROAD. A NEIGHBORHOOD COMPATIBILITY DETERMINATION TO ALLOW AN AFTER-THE-FACT ACCESSORY STRUCTURE BUILT IN THE EAST SIDE YARD; AND A VARIANCE FOR A DECREASE IN THE 10' SIDE YARD SETBACK FOR THE STRUCTURE.

Assistant Planner Wong gave a staff report (as per written material) and recommended that the Planning Commission: Open the Public Hearing; Take public testimony, Discuss the issues, Close the Public Hearing, and Adopt Resolution No. PA-07-04, approving this project.

CHAIRMAN KILLEN commented that the survey worked in the favor of the applicant such that the structure is further back from the street than originally thought.

COMMISSIONER O'DAY asked Staff to identify what had changed in the Planning Application from April to November that would justify the Variance.

Director Wahba discussed the issues and options that were presented, and commented that the combination of details affecting both the applicant and the neighbor in addition to the survey conducted, provided sufficient findings to support the Variance request.

COMMISSIONER O'DAY moved, seconded by COMMISSIONER BAYER

COMMISSIONER O'DAY discussed his concerns for approving an after-the-fact request and whether or not this could set a precedent. He commented that the new set of plans show that the structure should not be intrusive to the neighboring property and that if the structure were to be moved inside the allowed location, that it would be more intrusive.

COMMISSIONER SOMERS expressed his concerns for violators of the City's codes and that they repeatedly benefit. He also discussed that if the applicant had moved the accessory building it would have looked massive and out of place, so the alternative would have looked worse.
